Ofsted have also only resumed inspecting schools since September 2021 after what was a considerable amount of time where inspections were suspended due to the pandemic. As soon as the final report is out, we will share it with you. Thank you to all of you who took the time to complete the online questionnaire. strangeness falls away and we are able to simply appreciate being able to come together and enjoy the moment.
